

Window Air Conditioner

Thank you for purchasing the River Leaf Models Window Air Conditioner kit. Assembly is straightforward for beginners and experienced modelers alike. Your kit includes everything you need to produce the final assembly. We recommend using white glue such as Elmer's for this assembly. A sharp X-Acto knife and a sanding tool, preferably fine sandpaper.

Step #1 –Glue the Decorative Sides to the “Core.”

This is really the only step. Your kit includes a “block” (core) to which you will adhere the decorative sides. Your unit also includes two triangular wall supports. Carefully remove these from the parts sheet. The section in which these are located has two legs and this piece attaches to the core block and serves as the back of the unit. Use a very light coat of white glue to adhere these two parts.

The front of the unit is apparent, as are the two sides, which all have vents. Apply a very light coat of white glue to the core block and apply the front and sides. The remaining long narrow strip is applied to the top by the same method. Lastly, apply the two triangular supports beneath the unit.

Painting and finishing is up to you and the method you prefer. We spray these with grey paint and apply weathering chalk in black and rust colors.

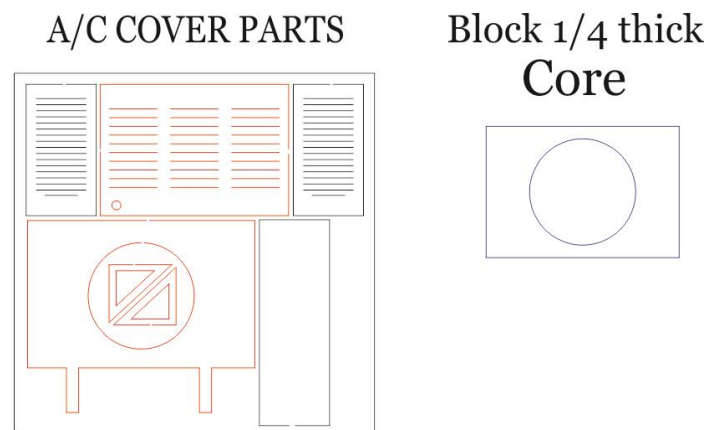


FIGURE 1 – A/C UNIT COMPONENTS
